# What is an Integrated Management System?

An integrated management system combines elements from different management systems, commonly quality, OH&S and environment, to create a single system to address the needs of the organisation.

This allows for a more consistent and efficient approach to management systems.

*With the recent revisions of ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 14001:2015, and now the release of ISO 45001:2018, organisations are able to integrate their Quality, Environmental, and OH&S/WH&S management systems like never before.*

## **Why do we need it?**

An integrated management system can benefit an organisation through increased efficiency and effectiveness, and offer cost reductions whilst also minimising the disruption caused by duplication.

A single approach to the management of business risk, be it quality, OH&S or environmentally related, allows an organisation to adopt a proactive methodology and stay ahead in a changing business environment.

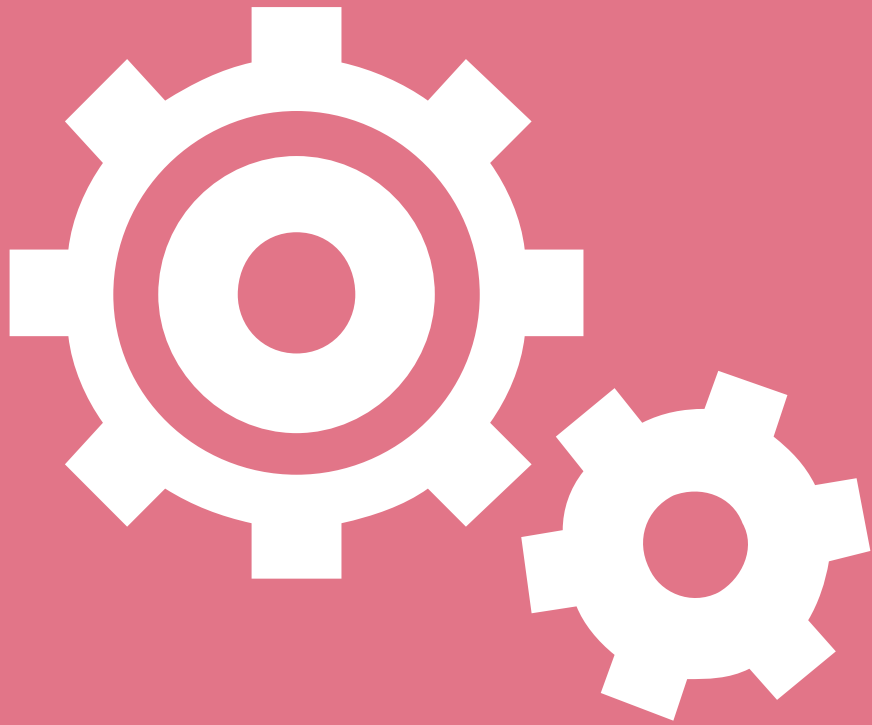
*An integrated system provides a clear, uniform image of the entire organisation, how each area impacts one another, and the associated risks.*

## **What are the benefits of an IMS?**

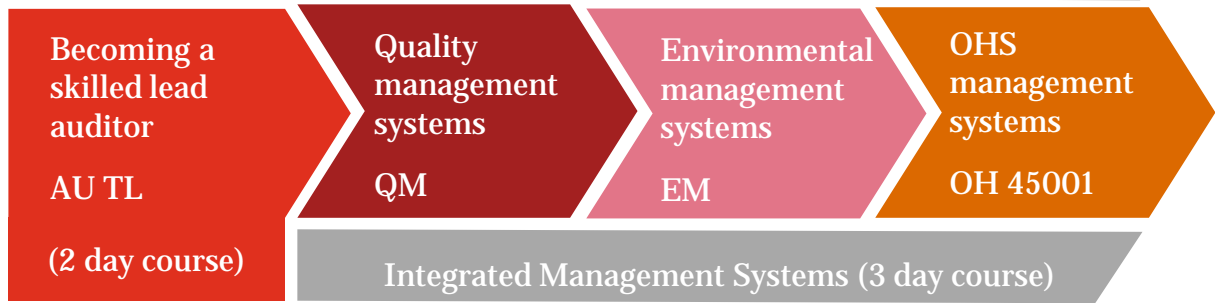
