What is ISO 27001?

ISO/IEC 27001 helps organisations to keep secure both their information assets and those of their customers.

Organisations of all types and sizes collect, process, store and transmit information in many forms. This information is valuable to an organisation's business and operations.

ISO 27001:2013 is a well-respected international information security standard that outlines the key processes and approaches a business needs to manage information security risk in a practical way.

Why do we need it?

Information security is a business problem, not an IT problem. Risk-based approaches are vital for modern information security effectiveness.

There are many ways to achieve security risk management, and a good standard like ISO 27001 puts formalities in place to ensure the right thought processes are followed and captured when the inevitable breach is realised.
